












## THE IMPACT

## **WE URGE GOVERNMENT TO:**

Rebase the temporary accommodation subsidy rate paid to local authorities to 2024 levels, to better ensure that local authorities retain 90% intended by the policy when first instigated. Allow housing authorities to levy a 2% council tax precept for housing (in the same way upper tier authorities can levy a precept for adult social care). Reform of government fiscal rules to incentivise long-term public investment in social housing. "Fixing these problems will prevent many local authorities running out of money over the next 12 to 24 months, which would ultimately cost the Government, taxpayers and society far more than the cost of acting now."
